









SITUATION REPORT DECEMBER 2023



SECURITY HIGHLIGHTS

attacks on health care reported by WHO SSA tool in Ukraine since February 2022 until December 2023.

On December 29, massive rocket and drone attacks resumed across Ukraine. On the first day of the massive attack Dnipro, Kharkiv, Kyiv and Zaporizhzhia were the most affected: private sectors and residential buildings were hit, and a shopping and entertainment center and a maternity hospital in Dnipro were destroyed. In Ukraine, 39 people died and 160 were injured.

On December 28, in the village of Bilenke, Zaporizhzhia region, an attack by the Russian Armed Forces resulted in the deaths of 2 people and injuries to 5 people. The mobile teams of the Zaporizhzhia project have been working with the Bilenkyi Primary Healthcare Center since 2023, we monitor security changes and adjust the work of our colleagues.


During December, the "Medicos del Mundo" Spain continued its humanitarian intervention in the Kharkiv, Zaporizhzhia, Kyiv and Chernihiv oblasts through the mobile unit to provide primary medical and psychological services. During December 2023, MUs provided 2806 primary health care consultations. Psychologists provided 775 mental health consultations.

- On the week of 11-15 December, the Problem Management + training took place in Zaporizhzhia. Social workers, psychologists, volunteers received the necessary knowledge to help with practical problems.
- December 14-15 SAR held training sessions for healthcare workers in Zaporizhzhia. The trainees learnt how to provide first aid according to modern protocols and even took part in an accident simulation: according to the trainers' scenario, doctors/nurses worked at the site of a missile strike. One group of participants treated the injured, while the other group provided assistance.
- To protect internally displaced population of Kharkiv oblast In December MdM (Spain) distributed 30 first aid kits for idps shelters: 17 small kits, and 13 big kits. 3635 people got access to basic medications, which can be used before the calling of emergency.











During December, the "Medicos del Mundo" Greece continued its humanitarian intervention in the Sumy oblast.

- Provision of PHC Services in 5 different locations through 1 MMU in Sumy oblast (3 different hromadas).
- Provision of MHPSS services in 5 different locations through 1 MMU in Sumy Oblast (3 different hromadas).

MUs provided 254 primary health care consultations. Psychologists provided 83 mental health consultations.













MdM Germany is resolute in its dedication to delivering indispensable healthcare services amidst the demanding conditions. The Mobile Units consist of doctors, midwives, psychologists, and promoters, working diligently to offer primary health care services. Significantly, the situation in Donetsk oblast remains extremely challenging. Access to medical services in this region continues to be severely restricted due to the absence of critical infrastructure.

In general, during December MdM Germany made 1 donation in Dnipropetrovsk oblast, 5 donations in Vinnitsa oblast, 2 donations in Donetsk oblast. The teams also performed a four-day training on MHGap for medical workers in Vinnitsa Oblast (18-21 December)

















Under current activities of the MdM France to build capacity on MHPSS for health staff working within the community in Ukraine, on 22 December 2023, a sub-activity of PFA training session was implemented in an isolated village of Novoinhulka in Mykolaivska Oblast.

This was the first of the several sub-activities to follow and organized with smaller groups of participants. In this session 6 participants were a family doctor and a nurse from an MHU, a village health point nurse, a village librarian who is in daily contact with the village children and caregivers and an MHU driver.

MHPSS Advisor MdM-France and its implementing partner, the Mykolaiv Regional Branch of the Ukrainian Red Cross Society, with the presence of her psychologist oriented these staff to purpose, core principles, process, and techniques of the PFA.

According to the family doctor, the MHPSS needs make up a significant portion of the needs of patients she is seeing and more basic MHPSS skills for her means less burnout. According to the Red Cross psychologist, in the absence of established joint referral pathways and absence of MHPSS services, the PFA is a basic intervention that links cases to the available indicated MHPSS services.

- Provision of primary health care in Mykolaiv Red Cross OPD
- Provision of primary health care in 20 different locations through 3 URCS MMUs in Mykolaiv oblast (3 different hromadas)
- Provision of health care to LGBTGI+ community in Odessa LIGA center.
- During December 2023, MUs provided 764 primary health care consultations.
 Psychologists provided 336 mental health consultations.
- Provision of MHPSS services in 20 different locations through 3 URCS MMUs in Mykolaiv oblast
- MR process on-going validation for the donation of medical and non-medical items to Health Facilities and IDP collective centers.
- Crisis Modifier: Snihurivka Hospital (Mykolaiv Oblast) confirmed to receive 1 Cholera Kit.
- Kherson MoH confirmed to receive 1 Cholera Kit and 1 NCD Kit.
